

Green Ash

Fraxinus pennsylvanica

Green Ash is a native, medium sized tree with an open, irregular crown reaching about 50 feet in maturity. The tree is fast growing on moist bottomlands and can withstand climate extremes once established. Green Ash grows around 2 to 3 feet per year.

Nannyberry

Viburnum lentago

Nannyberry is a native multi-stemmed shrub or small tree that may reach 36 feet in height at maturity. Suckers usually form at the base ensuring increased stabilization and expanded coverage.

Red Maple

Acer rubrum

Red Maple is a adaptable tree to a wide range of soil and site conditions. Red Maple grows to 40 to 60 feet at maturity. It has a fairly rapid growth rate of around 2 to 5 feet per year.

River Birch

Betula nigra

River Birch is a native tree that thrives in stream banks and other moist places. The tree grows up to 40 to 70 feet and 15 to 30 inches in diameter at maturity. River Birch bears around 375,000 seeds per pound which helps the tree expand and stabilize. The roots survive fire and spread vigorously. River Birch grows around 1.5 to 3 feet per year.

Arrowwood

Viburnum dentatum

Arrowwood is a native shrub growing 9 feet tall and spreading up to 8 feet at maturity. Wildlife are often attracted by the 1/4 inch bluish-black berries.

Cranberrybush

Viburnum trifolium

American Cranberrybush is a native shrub, averaging in height from 6-10 feet at maturity. The fruits, which ripen in September and October, resembles the true cranberry.

Eastern Cottonwood

Populus deltoids

Eastern Cottonwood is a fast growing tree reaching around 80 to 100 feet in height and 3 to 4 feet in diameter at maturity. It is very well suited to moist soils, and generally achieves vigorous growth in relatively short periods of time. This highly adaptable tree is also ideal for use as a windbreak.
